

- Lack of policy framework and the coordination

BEST PRACTICES

Publication: Dynamic access to information with Multiformat download option

The Croatian Bureau of Statistics is one of the biggest Croatian Open Data publishers with 79 datasets, mainly published in "dynamic" way using aspx framework. All these datasets are highly user-configurable (including precise filtering, sorting and downloading). Downloads are possible in various open or close formats including .json, and 8 kinds of different .csv formats.

Re-use: HAKmap

HAKmap is the most accurate Croatian GPS application with additional values in the field of transport information, like POI's including address book of health institutions and private practices published by Croatian health insurance fund. This multiplatform application (Android, iOS, interactive web version) is very popular in Croatia because of its accuracy together with sublimed local transport information.
