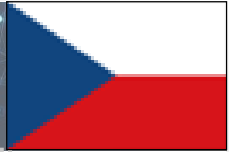

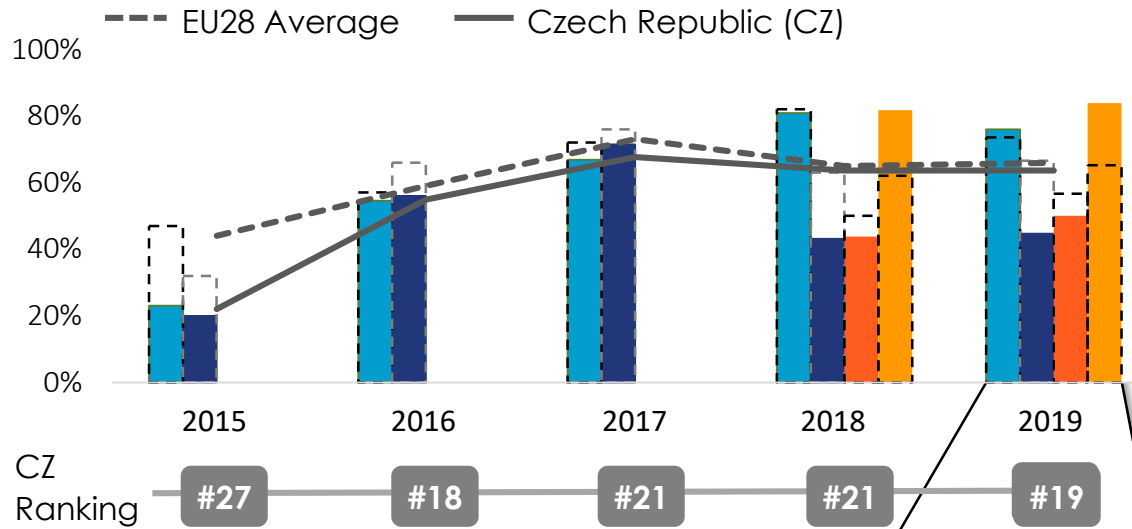

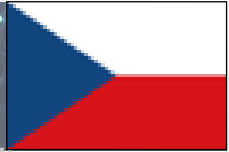


## MATURITY LEVEL RATING

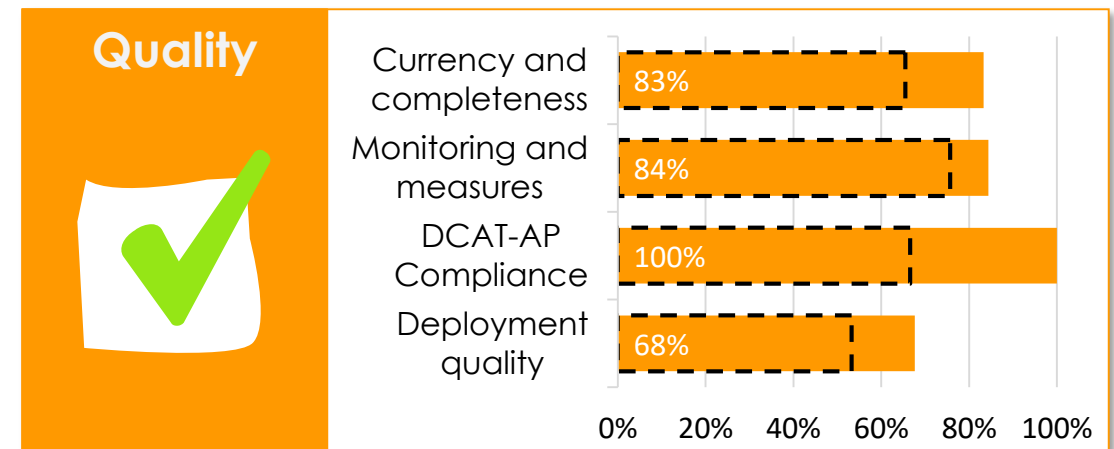
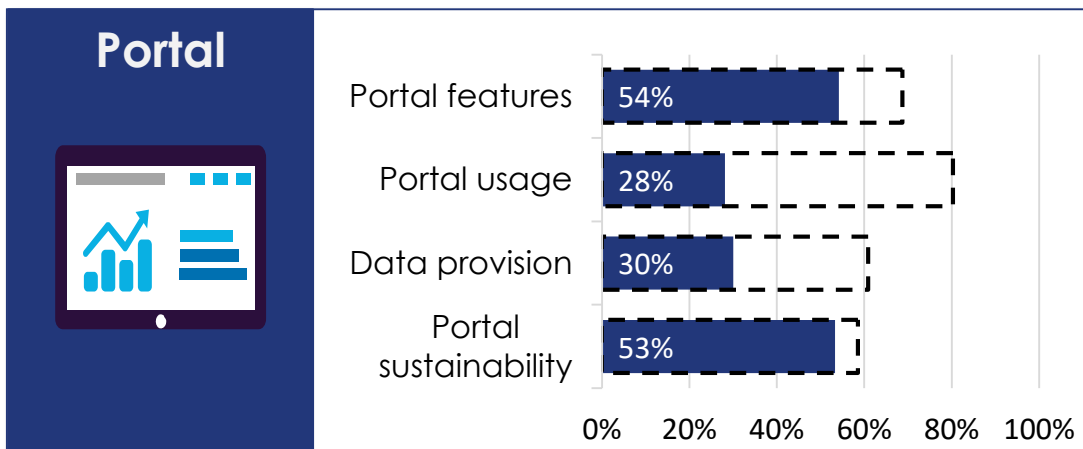
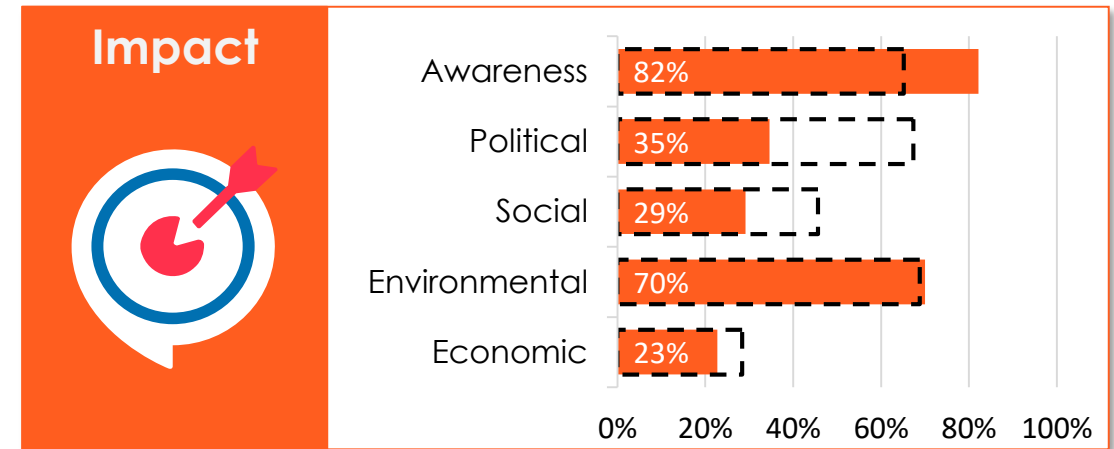
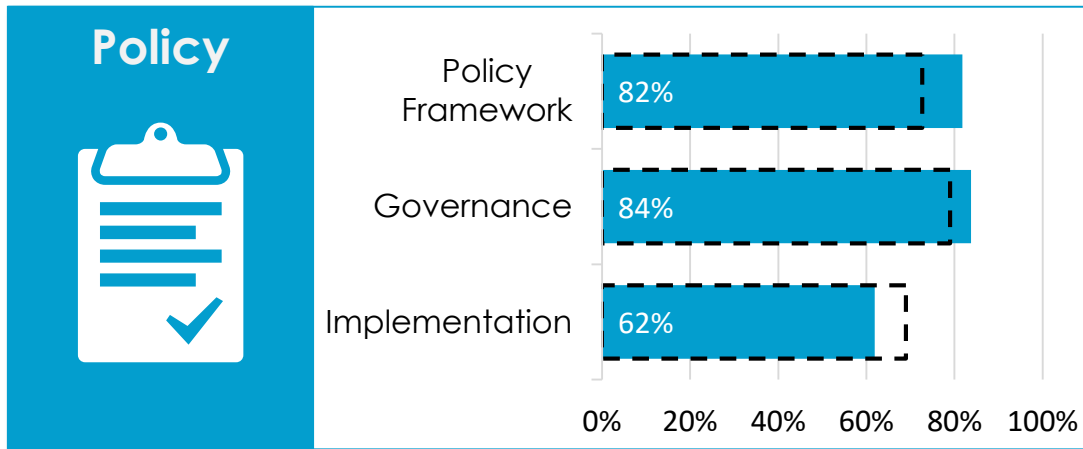


## OVERALL MATURITY LEVEL SEGMENTATION

## ADDRESSING BARRIERS



### Organisational

It is a challenge in the Czech Republic to find people in public sector bodies who are interested in publishing open data. Therefore, the team of the National Open Data Coordinator provides open data trainings for civil servants, workshops, and consultations for introducing open data policy into all public sector bodies. In addition, Open Data Working Groups are established within the ministries.



### Financial

A challenge is the lack of financial resources to support the re-use of data, e.g. creating start-ups and innovation hubs. Therefore, the project from the European Structural Funds "Implementation of Strategies in the area Open Data II" was launched in 2017.



### Awareness

To address the issue of low awareness of the availability of open data and the benefits that result from re-using open data, the Czech national open data portal organises multiple events throughout the year, such as hackathons and workshops.



## OPEN DATA RE-USE

The Czech Republic organises multiple activities to boost open data re-use in the country. Examples from 2019 are the [Open Data Expo](#), the [Annual Open Data Conference](#), and the [third Open Data Hackathon for Public Administrations](#). The Open Data Expo, for example, focused on two main topics: how business can help and benefit from open data, and how public authorities can open up their data.

In addition, the Czech Republic takes effort to measure the impact of open data. In 2017, a methodology for measuring the impact of open data was established. The results of the measurements are presented in the [Annual Report on the State of Publication of Open Data in the Czech Republic in 2017](#). The 2018 version of the report will be published on the national open data portal.

Although the national open data portal of the Czech Republic does not provide a designated area to showcase use cases, multiple open data use cases exist throughout the country. An example is the website [Czechcrime.org](#), that visualises different types of crime, based on crime statistics from the police.
