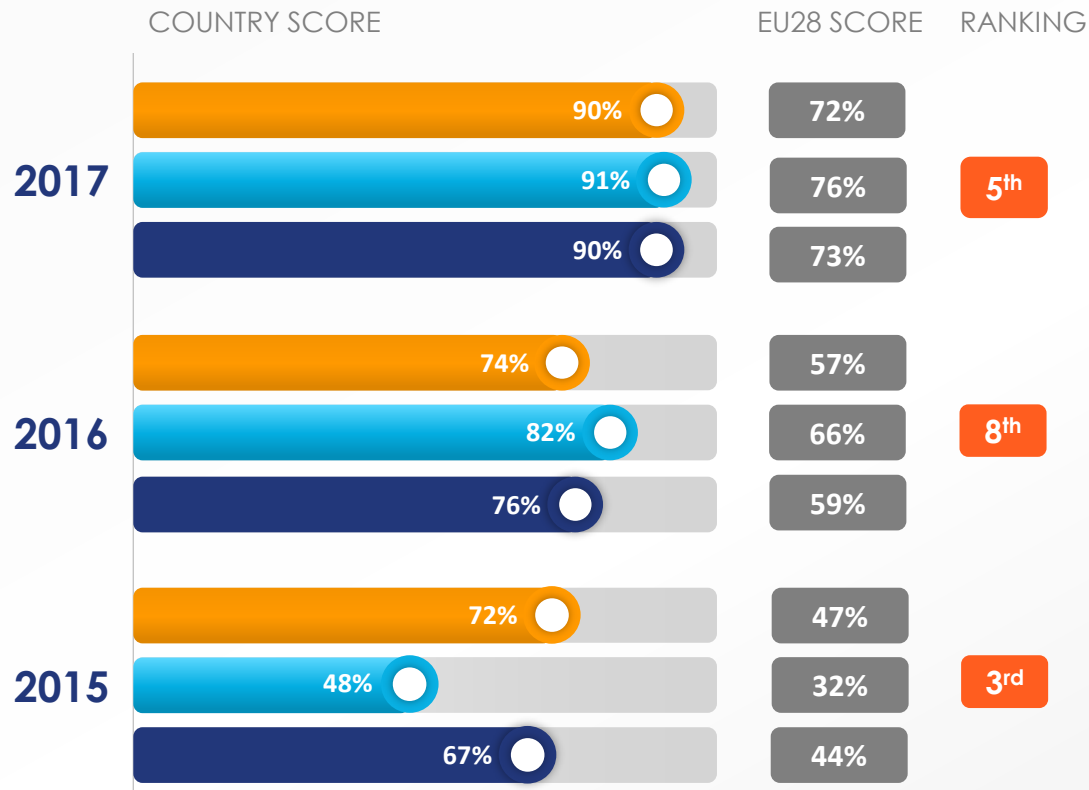

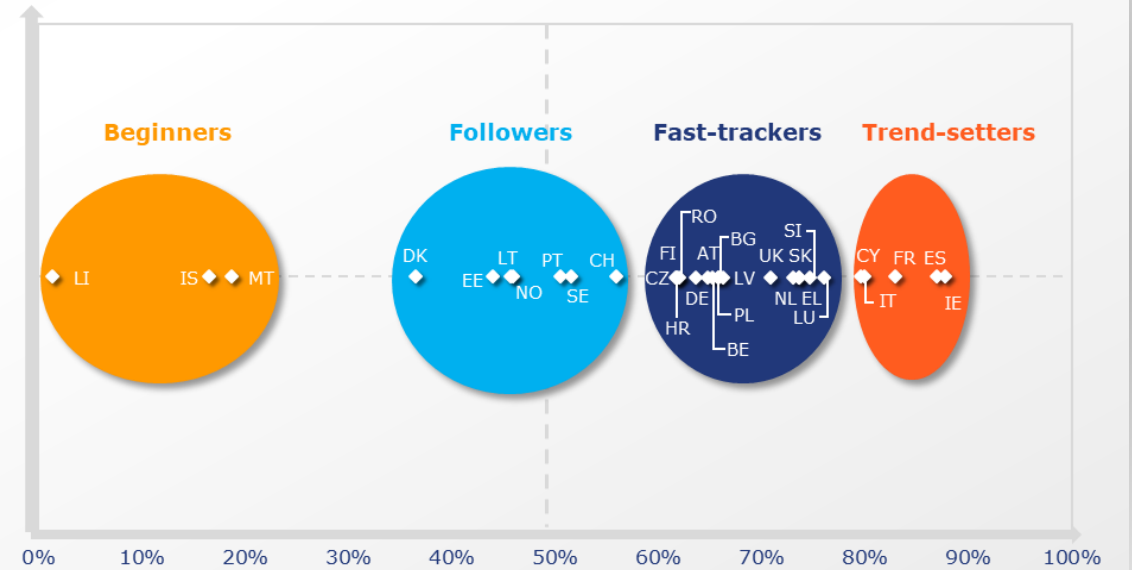
PROGRESS 2015-2017
