Open Data Policy

- ✓ Less than 2 events held annually

- X <25% data uploaded automatically



Licensing Norms

- ✓ 100% free of charge
- ✓ 50-74% open licensed
- X Policy recommends 'Instructions in re-using publishing information' due to a conflict between the National Information Act and Creative Commons.

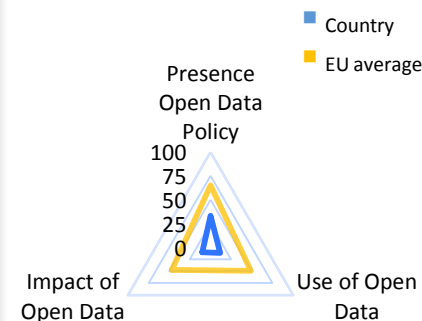


National coordination

Use & Reusability of Open Data

- 50 (0.015% of inhabitants in Iceland) unique visitors on average per month

- Most data sets are available in JSON format
- Data published by other administrations is unknown

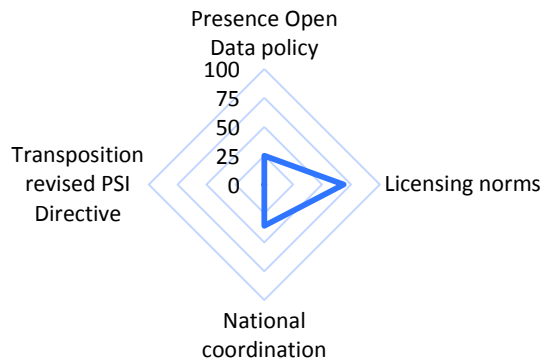

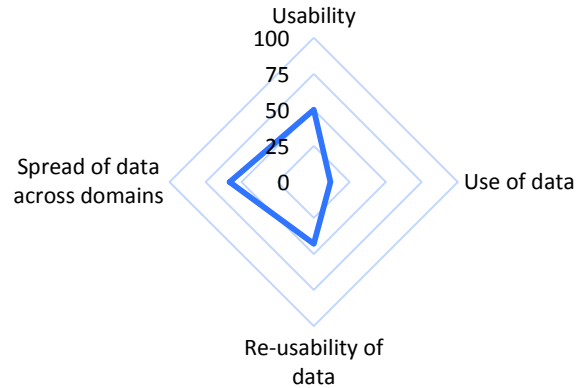

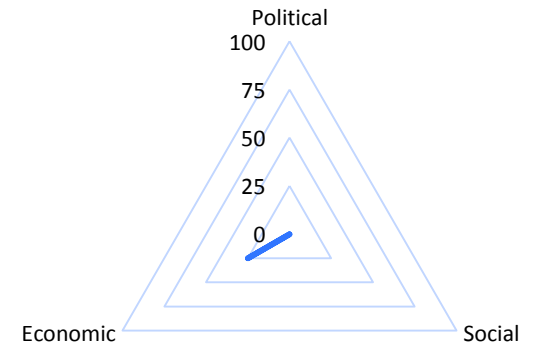
Open Data Readiness



Open Data Usability



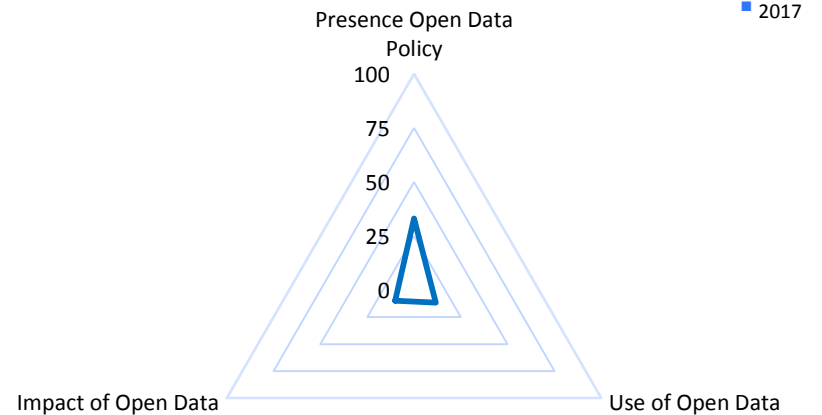

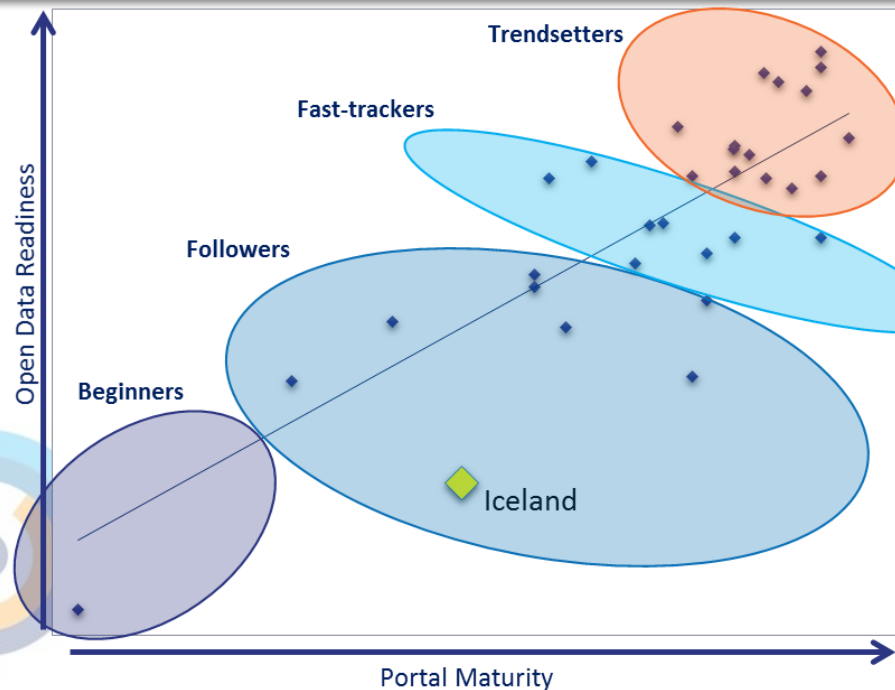
