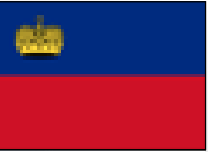


## OVERALL MATURITY LEVEL SEGMENTATION

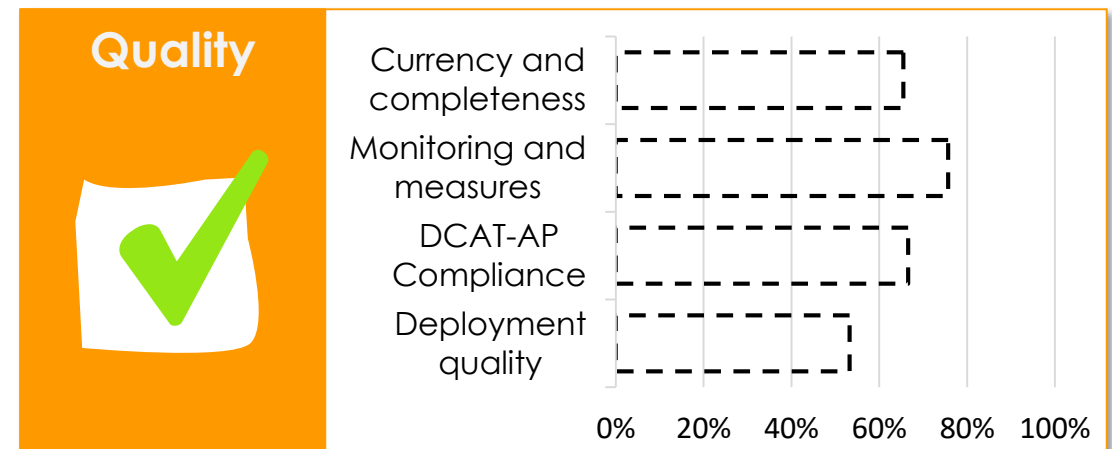
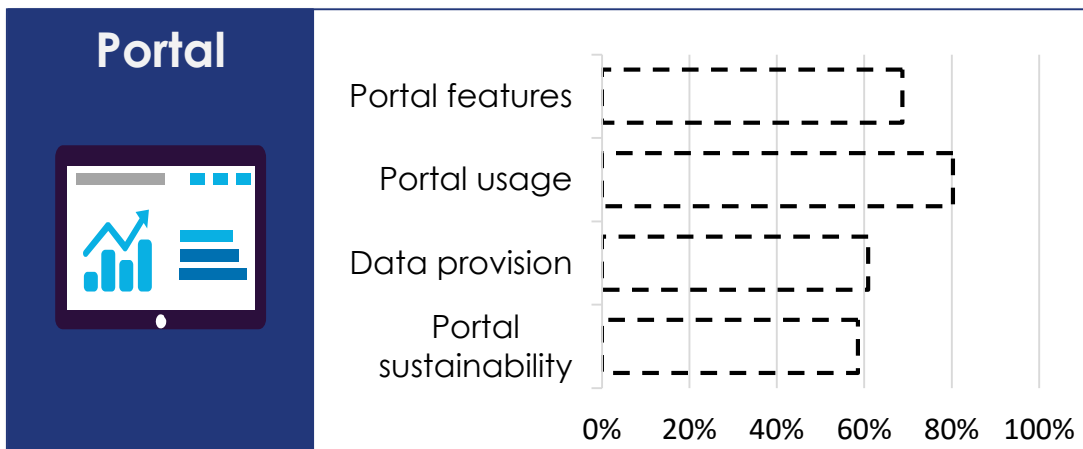
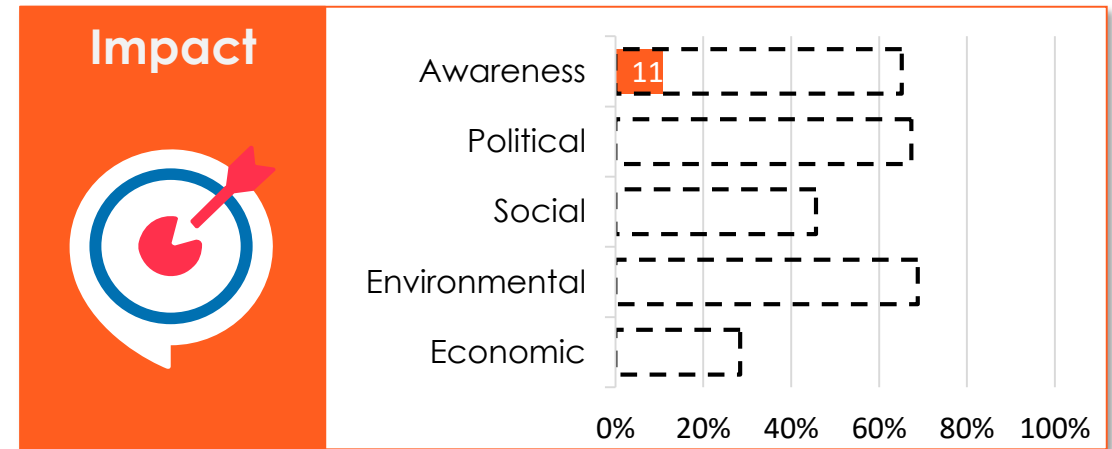
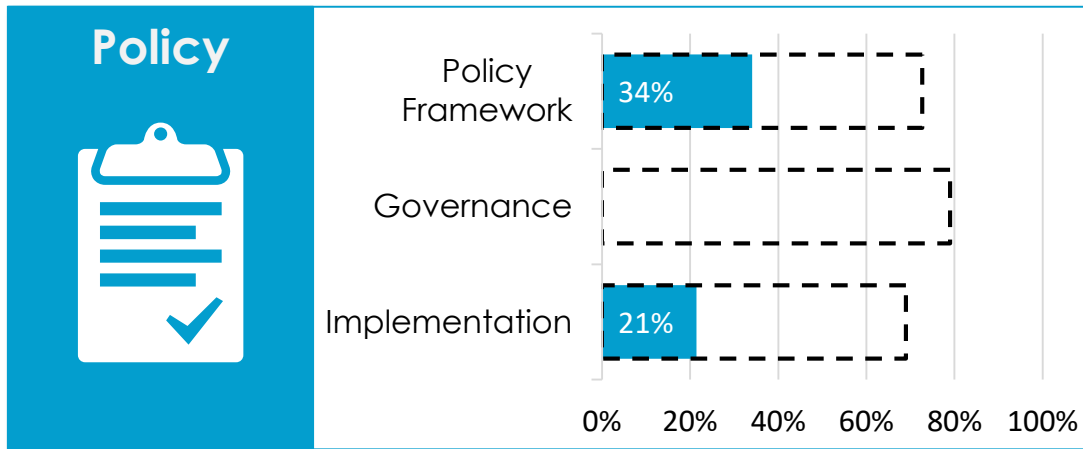

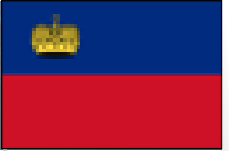




## DIMENSION PERFORMANCE

## ADDRESSING BARRIERS

The main barrier to open data publishing and re-use in Liechtenstein is that the implementation of the PSI Directive (Directive 2013/37/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 June 2013 amending Directive 2003/98/EU on the re-use of public sector information) is still ongoing and not completed yet.

In March 2019 the government published the [Digital Agenda](#) scoping concrete fields of action for the further digitisation of Liechtenstein. One of the objectives and focus expressed by the government is to ensure the availability of high-quality official geodata and facilitate its re-use through the use of open and machine-readable formats.

In April 2019 the [eGovernment strategy](#) was also published, describing Liechtenstein's vision, principles and guidelines for the implementation of digital services as well as defined action areas.



## OPEN DATA RE-USE

Although some public sector bodies in Liechtenstein publish their data in the open, such as the National Statistic Office of Liechtenstein, there is no national open data portal from which all open data can be accessed and re-used. The re-use of open data is not a priority in Liechtenstein, and there are no activities conducted to boost open data re-use.
