

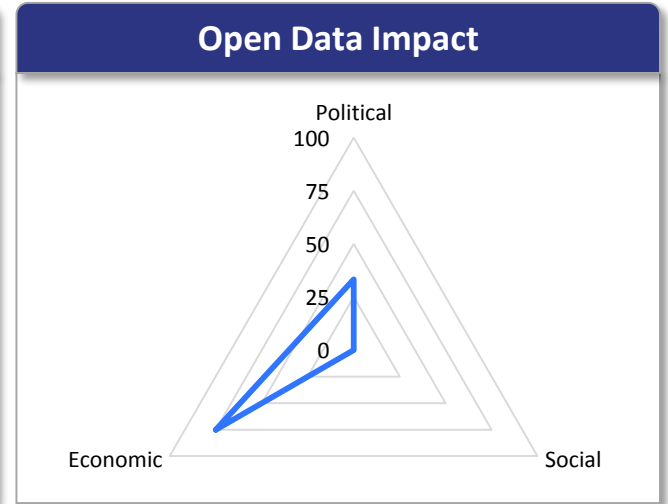
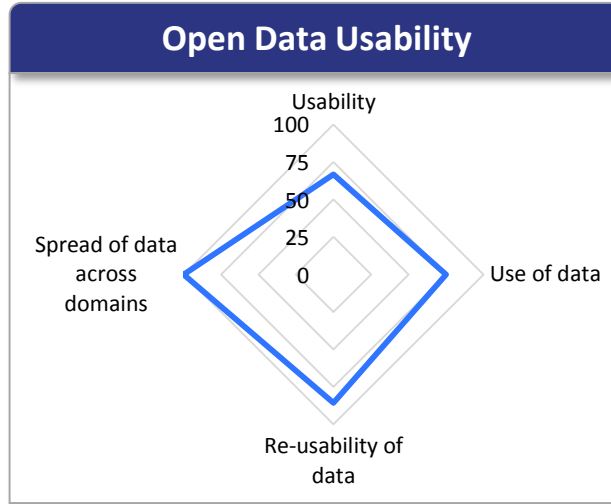
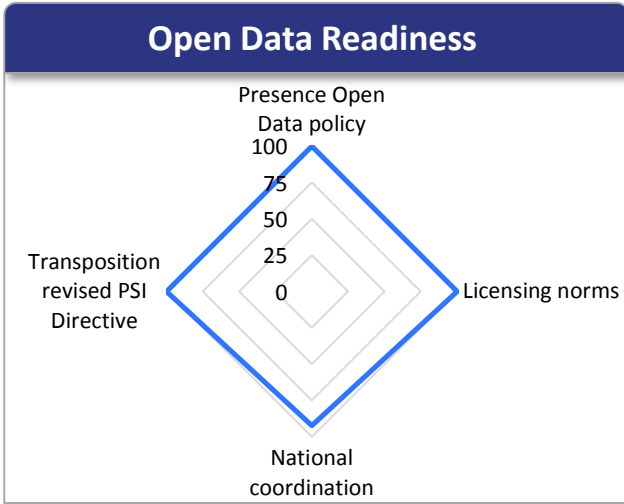
Best practices

- Climat game: The climate game is a virtual world where students are challenged to design the campus of their university climate adaptive.

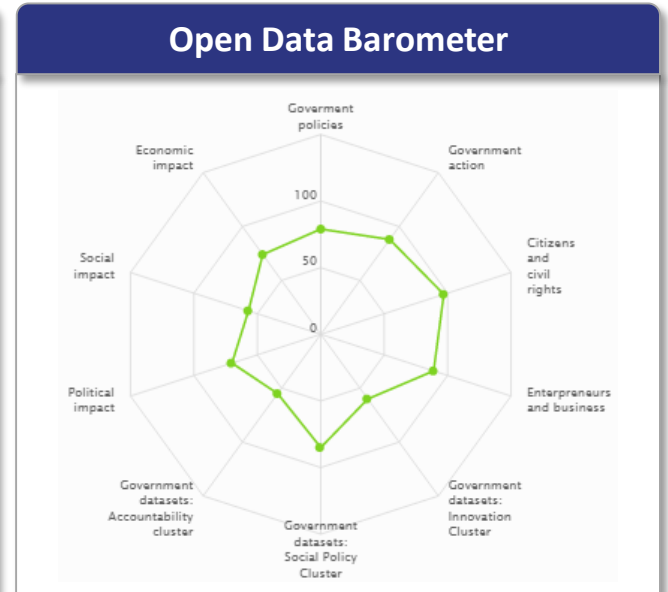
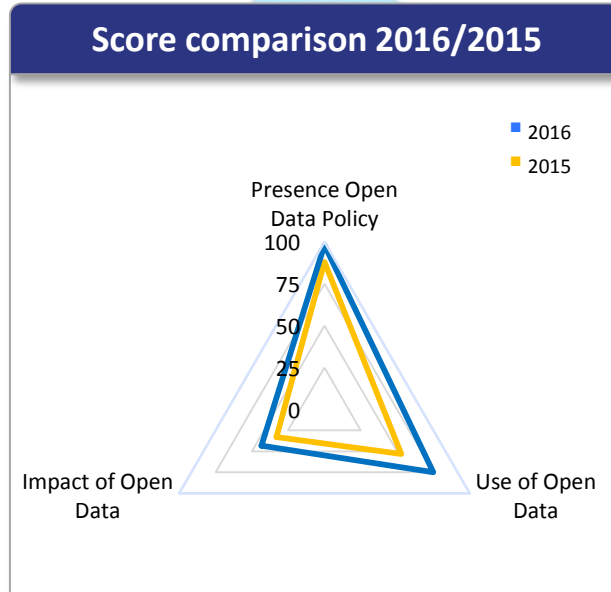


Progress on barriers

- The barrier existing for further publication, is addressed. To overcome the legal barrier data sets are provided supplied by the Central Bureau of Statistics.



- ### Major changes 2016
- Presence Open Data policy is at a maximum score this year, because more regional portals are integrated in the national portal.
 - Use of Open Data indicator has increased, mainly because the amount of unique visitors at the portal is better monitored.
 - Compared to last year the political impact has increased, resulting in an higher score on the indicator Impact of Open Data.

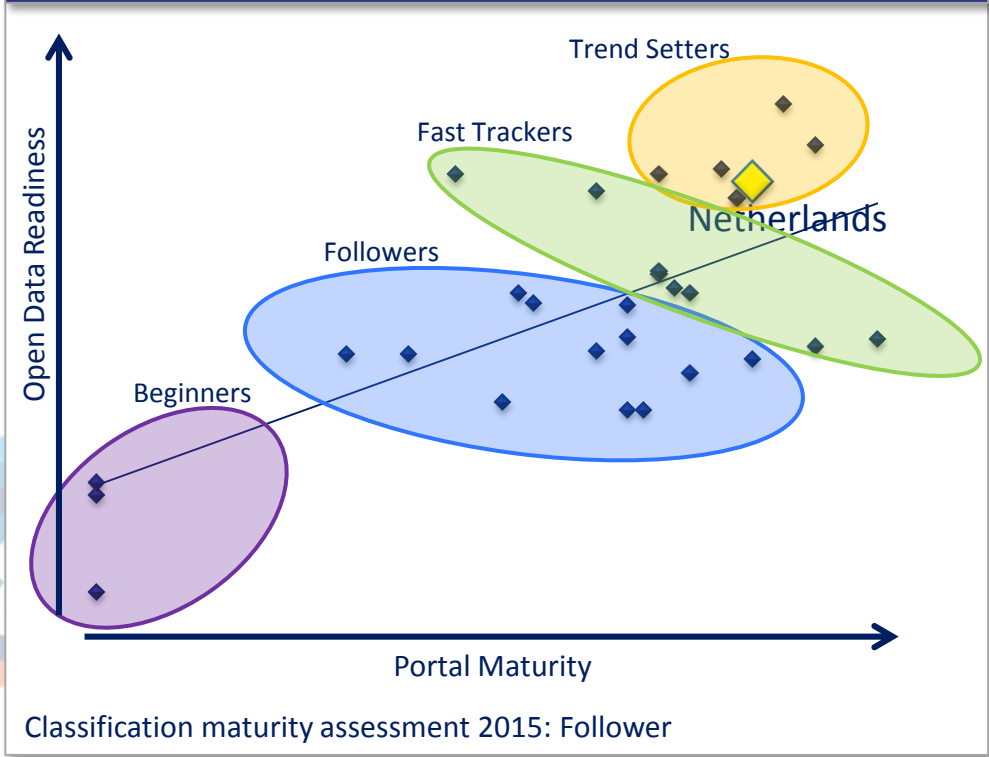
