

Use & Reusability of Open Data

- 3,450 (0.06% of inhabitants in Slovakia) unique visitors on average per month
- 10% of the visitors are foreign
- Unknown proportion of traffic generated by humans
- Typical profile of visitors is unknown
- Most data sets are available in CSV format
- 99% of the data sets are machine readable

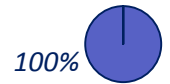

Barriers

Further publication

For further publication political and technical barriers exist.

- *Political barrier:* Passive approach of Open Data holders, mainly by municipalities.
- *Technical barrier:* Data publishers are not well aware of technical standards. There is little improvement of technical infrastructure for centralised publication of Open data.

Further use

For further use little awareness and low availability are present.

- *Little awareness:* Lack of deeper awareness occurs mainly at by municipalities.
- *Low availability:* There is a lack of available data sets.



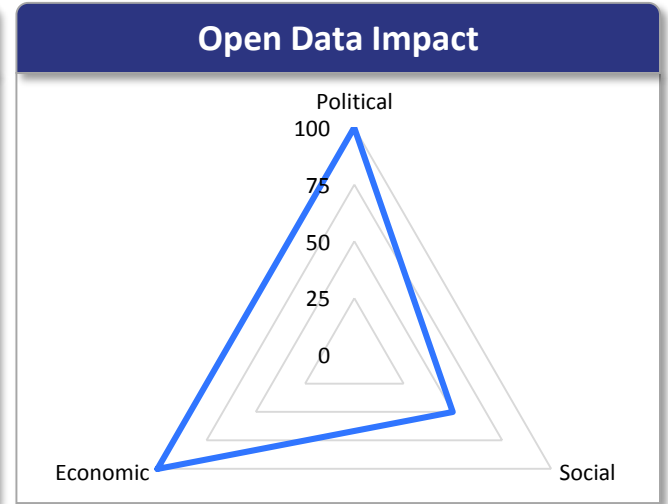
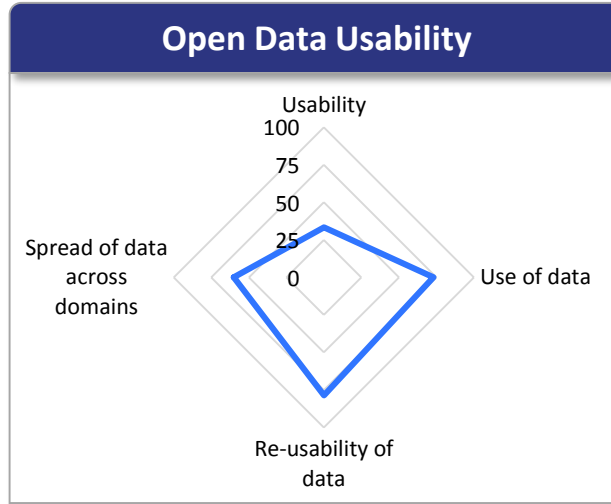
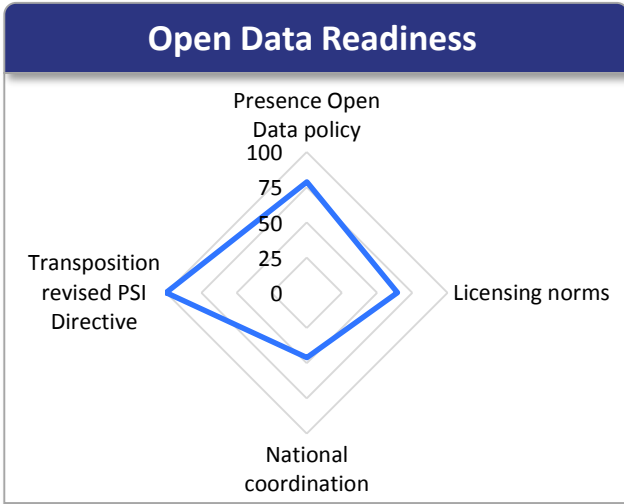
Best practices

- Central register of contracts: list of contracts awarded by ministries, central government authorities, public bodies and subordinate organizations of these institutions. Positive feedback was received from general public and media.
- Crime map: Visualising data from police and statistical office on maps of regions of Slovakia. Popular service relevant for general public, using accurate data. Has positively changed publication of relevant data by police.

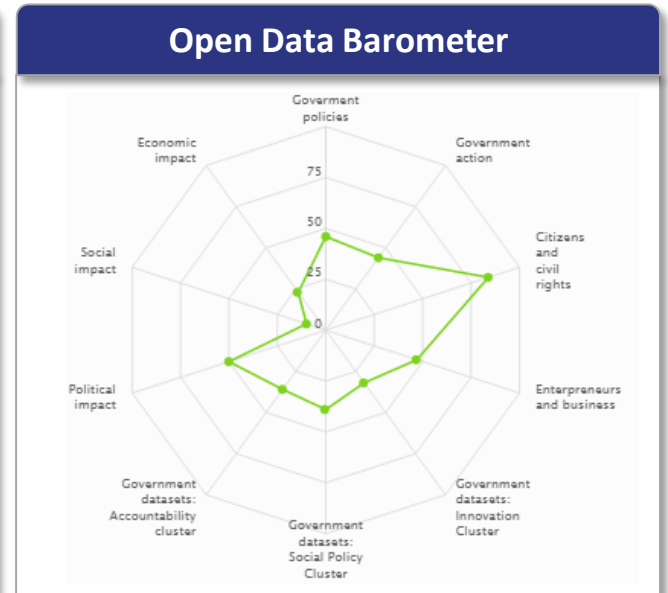
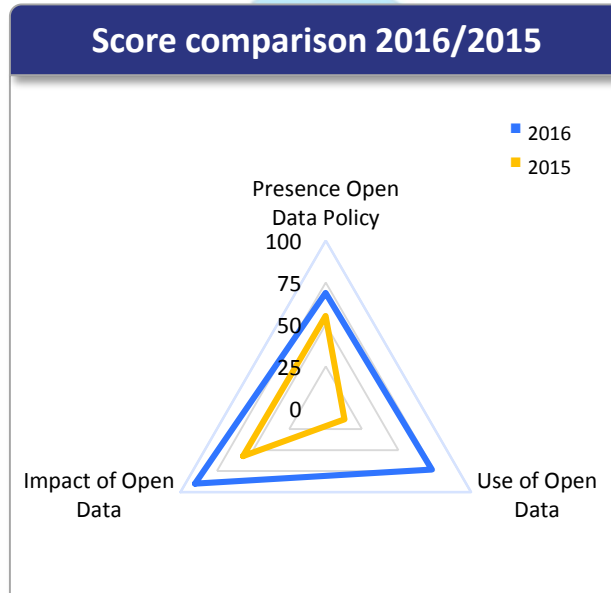


Progress on barriers

- The two barriers existing for further publication, are addressed. To overcome the political barrier a programme resolution of the new government was constructed. Guidelines for the publication of Open Data were published to overcome the technical barrier.
- The barriers that exist for further use, are not addressed.

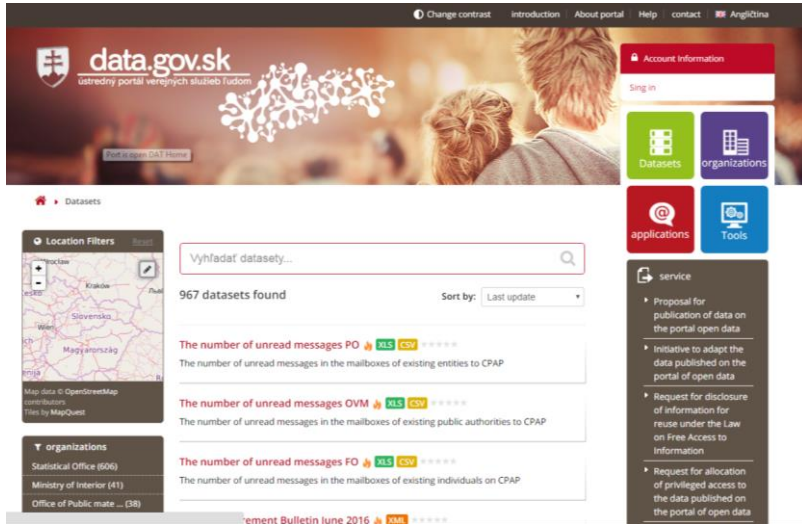


- ### Major changes 2016
- Presence Open Data policy increased thanks to a predefined approach to ensure all data sets are up-to-date, identification of priority domains and including regional portals in the national portal.
 - The national portal now measures the amount of unique visitors. The amount of visitors is large, which resulted in an increase in the Use of Open Data indicator.
 - Open Data Impact increased because more studies investigating the economic impact of Open Data, were done.

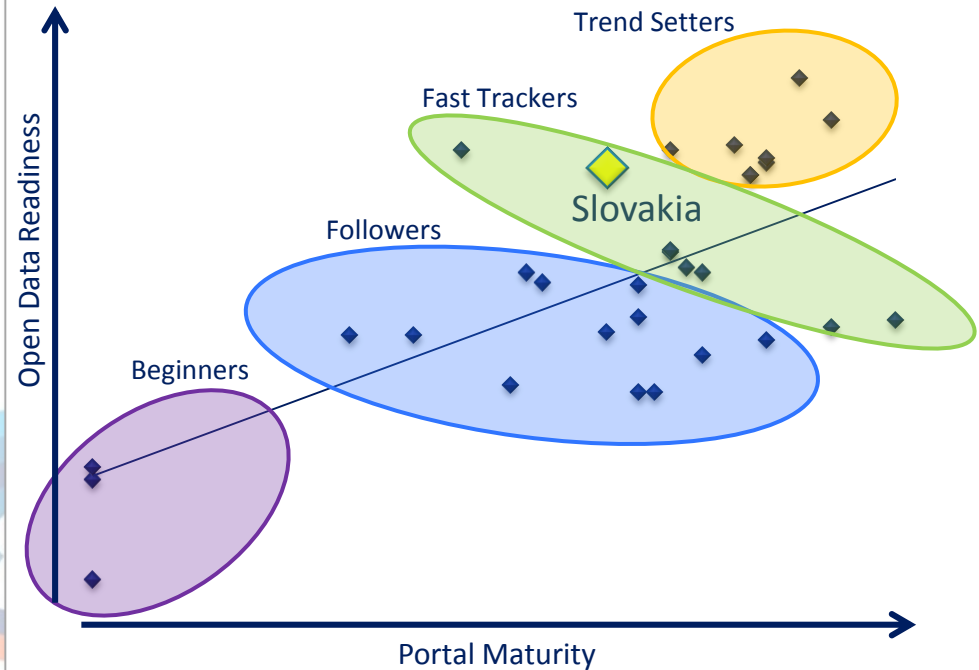




Print screen portal
